Little Sun launches at Tate Modern with a full programme of events – Sunlight Graffiti, Tate Blackouts, and the premiere of the Little Sun Films series



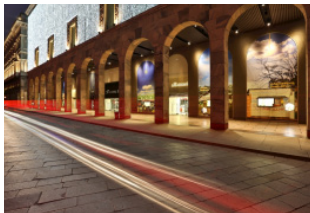
November

Imagine Burundi-Terimbere Foundation opens the first Little Sun shop in Burundi



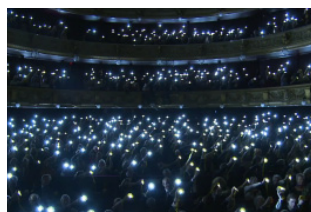
June: Khayelitsha township, South Africa

Constance Ntese becomes our first Little Sun sales agent in the region



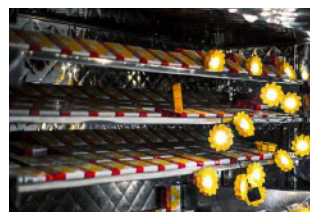
August: USA and Japan

Little Sun receives a \$5 million impact investment from Bloomberg Philanthropies



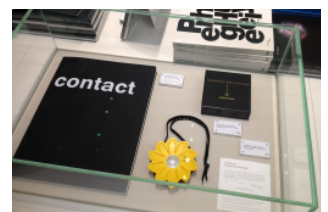
August: Reykjavik, Iceland

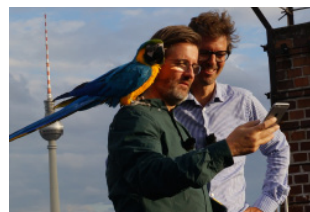
November 2014–March 2015
